Rocky Mountain Regional Masters (RMRM) won the Regional Club National Championship with 1,862 points - winning by more than 420 points! Congratulations to all RMRM members! Several USMS records were broken in San Antonio! Congratulations on these incredible swims by COMSA members, including:

- **Richard Abrahams, RMRM: men's 80-84 50 freestyle (28.15) and 50 butterfly (31.10)**
- **Karina Plocek, RMRM: women's 55-59 50 freestyle (24.84)**
- **Collette Sappey, RMRM: women's 60-64 50 freestyle (25.76)**

Rich, Karina (50 fly 26.89) and Collette all broke USMS records at the 2025 COMSA State Meet and lowered them again at Nationals! Congratulations!!

COMSA Coach of the Year &

Volunteer Service Award

COMSA awarded the COMSA Lou Parker Coach of the Year and the Jack Buchanan Service Award at the 2025 COMSA Masters Short Course Championships in April.

The Lou Parker Coach of the Year award was created in 1986 to recognize outstanding coaching. Past recipients were nominated by the swimmers they coach and selected based on their contributions to their team with respect to camaraderie, technical advice, motivation and support of team members.

Each year since 1983 COMSA has presented an award to one male and female who has made a significant contribution to Master's Swimming and COMSA. From 1983–2007 this award was named the Lt. Governor's Cup. In 2008, the award was re-named as the Jack Buchanan COMSA Service Award.

CONGRATULATIONS Richard Van Dyke on being named the 2025 COMSA Coach of the Year!

Richard VanDyke is the Head Coach at the Peterson Space Force Base Guardians in Colorado Springs.

Here's just some highlights of the gushing nomination that clenched his win.

Meghan is an enthusiastic Masters swimmer who is now on the board for RMRM - all of her hard work and volunteerism has helped grow the sport of master swimming.

Each year since 1983 COMSA has presented an award to one male and female who has made a significant contribution to Master's Swimming and COMSA. From 1983–2007 this award was named the Lt. Governor's Cup. In 2008, the award was renamed as the Jack Buchanan COMSA Service Award.

-Rich cultivates a vibrant, energetic, inclusive, and encouraging atmosphere where swimmers of all skill levels feel welcome, each striving toward their personal goals.

-He goes out of his way to coach newcomers, even hopping in the water to guide them and ease them into the workouts until they feel confident joining the rest of the team while still ensuring to give the advanced swimmers the attention they need as well.

-He thoughtfully designs two similar yet distinct plans for each practice—one for competitive swimmers and one for recreational swimmers. This ensures everyone is challenged. He's also quick to organize mini clinics, focusing on specialized areas like breaststroke, butterfly, or crossover turns.

-He goes above and beyond (again) by organizing creative and exciting monthly events such as Water Polo games and Water Obstacle Relay workouts. For these events, we have discovered he wakes up at 2am to ensure he has everything set up perfectly.

-Rain, snow, or biting wind, he's always there to welcome us with a warm smile. Regardless of the conditions, he bikes to the pool, braving early mornings, darkness, and winter's chill. His enthusiasm never wavers, greeting us at 4:30 a.m. as if his grueling commute were just another easy ride.

-When seeking the Coach of the Year, it's impossible to imagine anyone more deserving than Rich.
