SUBJ: Emergency Legislation accepted

The Legislation Committee has received a request to have the House of Delegates favorably consider the attached emergency legislation.

By unanimous vote of the Committee, we request this legislation be introduced to the House of Delegates, with our recommendation that the legislation be approved.

- 1. The Emergency Medical Plant form for National Championship meets shall be effective January 1, 1986.
- 2. The second page of the Emergency Medical Plan form shall be withdrawn immediately.
- 3. The bottom of the Emergency Medical Plan form for all other meets shall not contain the section titled Medical Information for Entrants.

In both cases investigation discloses that such information is not available to the attending personnel and as a result of the emergency nature of such incidents, attending personnel gather and evaluate their own information.
